The following table applies.

- (a) a student who is a full-time student; and
- (b) a student who is a part-time student; and
- (c) a student who is a part-time student who is a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident of New Zealand.

7. Transfers of credit, substitutions and cross-credits

This award adheres to the Credit Recognition and Transfer Regulations in effect at the time of application.

- (a) With the approval of the Academic Board, a student may apply for a transfer of credit of up to 60% of the total credit required for the award.
- (b) A student who has completed 30% or more of the credit required for the award may apply for a substitution of credit.
