1. Purpose of the Certificate

The Certi cate in English for Universit Stud is a 60 point (0.5 EFTS) pre-entr quali cation designed to prepare non-native English speakers for successful integration into mainstream undergraduate and postgraduate degree programmes.

2. Certificate Programme

The Certi cate comprises a programme of stud in academic English language and stud skills speci call in the conte t of New Zealand tertiar stud .

3. Admission Requirements

A candidate who wishes to enrol for a Certi cate in English for Universit Stud must:

- (a) be approved as a candidate b the Manager, Bridging Programmes; and
- (b) Undergraduate: either
 - have achieved an IELTS score of 5.5 with no band below 5.0, or a TOEFL internet-based score of 70, or a TOEFL paper-based score of 525 and a TWE 4 or equivalent; or
 - have achieved a C grade or higher in the Bridging Programmes preparator course EAP2; or
 - iii. have passed an English language pro-cienc test organised and carried out b sta of Bridging Programmes.
- (c) Postgraduate: either
 - i. have achieved an IELTS score of 6.0 with no

band below 6.0, or a TOEFL internet-based score of 80, or a TOEFL paper-based score of 550 and a TWE 4.5, or a Cambridge English Test CAE grade A or CPE grade C; or

have passed an English language procenc test organised and carried out b sta of the Bridging Programmes.

4. Requirements for Award of Certificate

To qualif for award of the certi cate, the candidate must:

- (a) complete to a satisfactor level such written, oral, practical and other work as the Programme Manager of the Certi cate in English for Universit Stud ma require;
- (b) pass BRDG 041 for undergraduate students;
- (c) pass BRDG 042 for postgraduate students
- (d) attain a grade of C or better, overall.

- (a) have normall attained the level of mathematics and/or statistics, and either science, commerce or liberal arts education equivalent to that attained in Year 12 in a New Zealand secondar school;
- (b) be pro cient in the English Language at the level of an IELTS score of 5.5 or a TOEFL paper-based score of 520 and TWE 4.0 (appro imatel) or TOEFL computer-based score of 190 and TWE 4.0 (appro imatel) or equivalent.

4. Requirements for Credit

To qualif for the award of the Certi cate, the candidate must:

- (a) complete such oral, practical, written and other work that the Programme Manager ma require;
- (b) pass si courses including (BRDG 004 or FOUN 040) and (BRDG 005 or FOUN 041), and one of (BRDG 007 or FOUN 042), (BRDG 021 or FOUN 043), or (BRDG 027 or FOUN 044);
- (c) attain a grade average of C or better across the full programme;
- (d) complete the certi cate within four semesters of initial enrolment. If the certi cate is not completed within three semesters, the candidate must

Upon qualif ing for the award of the Certi cate, the candidate ma appl to the Registrar for admission into a course of stud for degree programmes as approved b the Academic Board.
