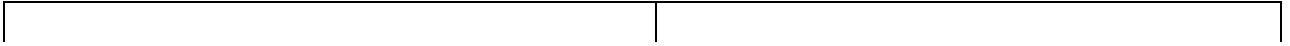




Life of a Scientist



	<p>Each bird that is caught has coloured tags placed around its legs. These do not hurt the bird but mean the scientists can tell which bird is which. Each bird is weighed by placing it upside down in a small tube. This stops the bird getting too frightened.</p>
